### Semantic classes of referent

hum	<i>human</i>	human beings and anthropomorphized non-humans
anm	<i>animate</i>	animals
inm	<i>inanimate</i>	inanimate physical objects
bdp	<i>body part</i>	body parts of human beings and animals
mss	<i>mass</i>	non-individuable masses like water or sand
loc	<i>location</i>	physical locations and places
tme	<i>time</i>	points or periods of time
abs	<i>abstract</i>	emotions, thoughts, ideas, speech, etc.

### Relations between referents

- < *set member of* (partial co-reference)  
is member of a previously introduced referent containing multiple entities
- > *includes* (split antecedence)  
contains multiple entities previously established as separate referents
- M *part-whole*  
is part of another entity or mass that was previously established
