Background to the data set

The texts were recorded in situ during fieldwork by Maryam Nourzaei, much of it in the course of her PhD project (see Nourzaei 2017 for details), and later transcribed and analysed by her. All three source texts are available as fully transcribed, translated, and glossed texts: Text A is available as a pre-publication pdf (Nourzaei, In preparation), while texts B and C both stem from published work (Nourzaei 2017).
